



New Born Baby Hat



Hey, Little Gem here; I have been crocheting for as long as I can remember, and a few months back, someone gave me the idea that I should start making a note of my patterns so I can share them with others, so this is me giving it a go!

The inspiration for me making baby clothes is my best friend. I've always been someone who likes to make/create things for the people I care about, so when I knew she was having a baby I knew straight away I needed to start making some clothes for him (He has been born know so I know that he is a he!) As I just wanted to add a personal touch to the first of (what I assume will be many) gifts for him.

I have made these instructions as beginner-friendly as possible but if you have any problems I have tutorials which will help over on my Youtube channel -LittleGemsCrochetCompany

What you will need:

- ♡ 5.5mm hook
- ♡ 1 ball of baby-safe yarn - DMC 100% Baby Cotton in Beige
- ♡ Tapestry needle
- ♡ Scissors

Abbreviations you will need to know:

- ♡ SS- Slip Stitch
- ♡ SC – Single Crochet
- ♡ DC – Double Crochet
- ♡ CH - Chain



Hat – Top Section

Start by creating a magic ring. If you are unsure on how to do this, please check out the tutorial on my Youtube page.

Round 1:

- ❖ SS into the magic ring
- ❖ Chain 2 (does not count as a stitch)
- ❖ Work 10 DC into the magic ring
- ❖ Pull the yarn tail to tighten the ring into a circle
- ❖ SS into the first actual DC (not the chain 2)



Round 2:

- ❖ Chain 2
- ❖ Work 2 DC in each stitch from the previous round
- ❖ SS into the first DC to close the round.



Round 3:

- ❖ Chain 2
- ❖ Work 2 DC in the first stitch
- ❖ Work 1 DC in the next stitch
- ❖ Repeat this pattern
- ❖ SS to the first DC to join



Round 4:

- ❖ Chain 2
- ❖ Work 2 DC in the first stitch
- ❖ Work 1 DC in each of the next 2 stitches
- ❖ Repeat the pattern around
- ❖ SS to the first DC to join



Rounds 5–8:

- ❖ Chain 2
- ❖ Work 1 DC in each stitch around
- ❖ SS to the first DC to join



The Brim

- ❖ Chain 6
- ❖ Turn your work, SC back down the chain (5 stitches)
- 1. SS into the stitch at the bottom of the chain you just created
- 2. SS into the next stitch along
- 3. Turn your work
- 4. SC back up the 5 SC, using back loops only
- 5. Chain 1, turn, and single crochet down again using back loops only
- 6. Repeat steps 1 – 5 round the entire hat
- ❖ Once the brim wraps all the way around, join the two ends together with a SS

Final Touches:

- ❖ Use your tapestry needle to sew in the ends securely
- ❖ Trim any excess yarn
- ❖ Fold up the brim of the hat for a finished look

You're done!

You now have your new born baby hat! I hope you enjoyed making this hat as it makes a great present for someone else or just a personal touch for your own little one!
